Parking Around Lower Green

The Parish Council is continuing to receive complaints from parishioners about inconsiderate parking along the north side of Lower Green resulting in other vehicles being unable to pass without driving over the green. This obviously has safety implications for pedestrians. The Parish Council is disappointed at the damage to the green particularly considering the huge expense incurred to restore it and is liaising with the school about other options available for parking such as the Rose & Crown pub car park.

Driving Using Mobile Phones

Please be aware that from Wednesday 1^{st} March 2017 there will be legislative changes around the usage of mobile phones whilst driving, or whilst sitting with the engine running. The key difference is that the penalty will rise from 3 points to 6 points on a driving licence and from £100 to a £200 fine.

THE PAVILION COMMUNITY INTEREST COMPANY (CIC) Upper Green, Upper Green Road, Tewin Herts.

The above CIC is a company which has been appointed by The Tewin Parish Council to run the Pavilion for and on behalf of the parishioners of Tewin. The CIC is run by volunteers who are themselves Tewin Parishioners. The Pavilion is now utilised by many organisations and provides a broad range of additional facilities to our village including Cricket and Tennis functions (as this is both sports' club house), Pilates, Art classes, Bridge Club, The Classic Car Show, Apple Day and private functions.

As with many village organisations it can be difficult to get volunteers to help with the running of such things but I would ask you to consider the positions listed below.

We are looking for a booking manager to look after our Hirers Calendar. This involves taking requests for hire mainly by e.mail but sometimes by phone and informing them if the Pavilion is available and telling them prices etc. If the hirer wants to proceed it involves forwarding them a booking form etc. Again this is done by e.mail and although there are a few busy times of year, for example when the Cricket Club and Tennis Club put in their annual bookings, generally I would estimate you would need to spend between half an hour and two hours per week doing this task.

We also require another Duty Officer to join our team. This entails meeting a Hirer at the pavilion at a preset time, letting them in and showing them around, returning at the end of hire to check everything is ok and locking up. These duties are done on a one off basis, and usually an individual duty officer will not volunteer more than once a month.

If you feel you can help us with either of the above please contact me and I will be glad to explain further.

To help run the Pavilion for the village improves the facilities in the village which in turn helps to make our village such a lovely place to live.

Team Vicar's Letter

Last month a group of us from Tewin and Datchworth received a generous welcome to Luton Central Mosque.

"Ask us anything", said our hosts "and don't be afraid of causing offence."

So, through questions and conversation, we learned more of the symbolism and depth of Muslim worship, the humility of Islamic prayer and the importance of community.

They talked candidly about what it is like to be a British Muslim and spoke at length about their frustrations with Islamist extremists. Islam, they told us, is meant to be a 'middle path'. The word 'jihad', which translates as 'struggle', should be a reference to our internal struggles to live well and never should be adopted as an excuse for war. The Qu'ran teaches, they told us, that if you kill one man, then you kill all of humankind. "Isis", said one man "do not know their Qu'ran". They spoke of all they were doing to protect their children and young people from radical views.

We also heard about the attempts that this mosque is making to build relationships with their neighbours of other faiths and none. Once a year they buy a thousand red roses and carefully remove every thorn. They then hand them out as gifts in Luton town centre and to church congregations as a symbol of love.

They also had paid for the words of Mohammed to be placed on the side of buses, as a way of allowing others to know the heart of their faith – "Feed the hungry, spread peace" it read. And so, gracious, gentle and generous, our hosts embodied that command as they sent us home with stomachs fed by home-cooked food and hearts warmed by such a welcome.

Mothering Sunday

Mothering Sunday was a day in Lent when the fasting rules were relaxed, in honour of the 'Feeding of the Five Thousand'.

It is known on this date, about four hundred years ago, people made a point of visiting their nearest big church (the Mother Church). The church in which each person was baptised. People who visited their mother church would say they had gone "a mothering."

Young British girls and boys 'in service' (maids and servants) at the local Manor House were only allowed one day to visit their family each year. This was usually on Mothering Sunday. Often the housekeeper or cook would allow the maids to bake a cake to take home for their mother.

The most favoured cake was - as it still is in some families - the 'simnel cake'. The Simnel cake is a fruit cake. A flat layer of marzipan (sugar almond paste) is placed on top of and decorated with 11 marzipan balls representing the 12 apostles minus Judas, who betrayed Christ.

It was not eaten on Mothering Sunday because of the rules of Lent, instead it was saved until Easter.

The word simnel probably derived from the latin word 'simila', meaning fine, wheaten flour from which the cakes were made.

Tewin Cowper School Pool Update

I am pleased to say that the work on the school pool commenced in February - very exciting! I would also like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who donated to the pool fund. Without your donations we would not be able to carry out the pool refurbishment. We received some truly amazing donations, including from the Barrett Bells, Under 5's and John Lewis just to mention a few. Thank you all so much! One of the school dads has also offered to source the new shed and install it, only charging for the materials. It is truly amazing the generosity we have received from so many of you. Without this much needed refurb we would definitely not be able to open the pool this summer. It was well and truly running on its last legs. It is a huge undertaking, not just financially but labour intensive as well. Other than having the pool as a shell everything else will need to be replaced - pipes, shed, pumps, filters, skimmers, sumps, inlets and new electrics. Obviously this all does come at a price, a total cost of £33,000 to be precise! Which is more than we had anticipated. We are therefore looking to raise an extra £5000 to cover the additional cost and leave us with a small surplus in case of any contingency. We are also looking for any plumbers who might be able to help with the closing of some pipes, and someone who would be able to do some pointing around the pool. If you can help or know of someone please do let me know.
