Get to Know Your Defibrillator

You may have noticed that we now have a defibrillator in Tewin which was supplied by the Pavilion CIC and is in a special safe provided by the Friends of Tewin. It is on the outside wall of the Pavilion. So that we know how to use it in a cardiac emergency, the CIC will be running a series of short sessions for anyone in Tewin when you can handle the machine and find out all you need to know to help a friend or family member. The sessions will last 30- 45 minutes and they will be held in the Pavilion during the day and in the evening.

A defibrillator is simple to use. Audio instructions are given, but it is essential to know your way around. Defibrillators are effective in 80 - 85% of cases when they are used PROMPTLY. Their success rate drops by 10% for every minute wasted. Presently, they are very underused mainly through lack of training. CPR needs to be used alongside the defibrillator, so separately, a short course will also be run.

The first course will be on the **20th of June.** The CPR course will be held at the Pavilion from 7-8 p.m. and can take 10 people. There will then be a 15 minute refreshment break followed by a course about the defibrillator. This course can accommodate up to 20 people. You can sign up for the first course or register your interest with Joanne Allen -

jrallen14@hotmail.co.uk, or 01438-798749 where you can leave a message if there is no reply. When there is an indication of numbers a list of further dates and times will be made available. There will be no charge for the courses.

Don't refrain because you feel you may not be strong enough to help. Knowledge and confidence are vital parts of saving someone's life before the arrival of the emergency services. You can help. Come, and bring a friend. Joanne Allen

<u>Tewin Parish Council Accounts for the Financial Year Ending 31st March</u> 2017

At the Annual Parish Council meeting on 8th May 2017 the Parish Council unanimously resolved to accept the accounts for the financial year ending 31st March 2017 and they were signed by the Chairman and the Clerk as the Responsible Financial Officer.

<u>Tewin Parish Council Annual Return for the Financial Year Ending</u> 31st March 2017

At the Annual Parish Council meeting on 8th May 2017 the Parish Council unanimously resolved to accept and approve Section 1 Annual Governance Statement on the Annual Return 2016/2017 and Section 2 Accounting Statements for 2016/2017. The Annual Return was signed by the Chairman and the Clerk as the Responsible Financial Officer.

Planning Application 3/17/0722/OUT - Land East of Upper Green Road, Tewin

Construction of 9 dwellings consisting of 4 x 3 bedroom and 5 x 2 bedroom dwellings with two new vehicular accesses - Tewin Parish Council agreed to object to the proposal as the applicant has not justified building on Green Belt land, the proposals are incompatible with the submitted District Plan and therefore not a sustainable development and it would create a precedent for other developers with land around the village. The Parish Council also supported parishioners comments against the proposed application.

Tewin Tennis Courts

We would like to bring to the attention of all parishioners that they may use the tennis courts on Upper Green without joining Tewin Tennis Club, provided that they abide by the normal booking and playing rules. A returnable key is available from Tewin Stores, Hertford Road in exchange for a contribution towards maintenance of £5 per hour per court (£2.50 for juniors).

<u>Drivesafe</u>

In December 2016 Tewin Parish Council supported Tewin Drivesafe's grant application to the Herts Commissioner's Road Safety Fund to cover the purchase and installation cost of a fixed flashing solar powered speed indication device at a location in the parish to be discussed with the police and Herts Highways.

We are pleased to report that Tewin Drivesafe has been successful in their grant application.

Visit to Anglesey Abbey on Wednesday 12th July 2017

The Anglesey Abbey estate in Cambridgeshire was formerly the home of Lord Fairhaven, who gifted the estate to the National Trust upon his death in 1966. In the house there are fine furnishings, books, paintings, silver and rare clocks:- all giving a feeling of opulence, reflecting the luxurious lifestyle. The grounds of the property are extensive (114 acres) and offer vibrant colour and the simple pleasures of nature. Since our visit will be in July, we should be able to fully enjoy the magnificent sweeping herbaceous border packed with colour and also the heady scent of the Rose Garden. Only a relatively small portion of the estate is so intensely cultivated but there are plenty of other things to explore in the grounds, including Lode Mill and one of the finest collections of garden statuary in the country. There is something there for everyone, so come along and join us for a great day out!

If you are a member of the National Trust then you are entitled to free entry to the whole property. The price will be £12 for THACS members and £15 for non-THACS members. You must bring your membership card with you so that it can be scanned.

If you are not a member of the National Trust, you have two access options:- if you would like to visit the house, choose the "Whole property" option (£24 for THACS members, or £27 for non-THACS members), which will give you access to everything. Otherwise, choose the "Garden & Mill only" option, which will give you access to everything except the house (£19 for THACS members or £22 for non-THACS members).

We will be travelling by coach, which will leave Tewin (from the bus stop opposite the Rose & Crown) at 9:30am and will leave Anglesey Abbey for the return journey at 3:30pm.
