TEWIN PAVILION, UPPER GREEN

It has been reported to the Parish Council that there have been incidents of young teenage children climbing on the pavilion roof and we would like to ask local parents to warn their children of the dangers of this as well as the possibility of damaging the roof covering and causing internal rainwater damage to the pavilion.

HIGHWAYS FLASHING SPEED SIGN

We are still waiting on Highways for an installation date for the flashing speed sign at Upper Green.

PARISH PATHS PARTNERSHIP (P3) GRANT

A P3 grant of £1000 has been granted towards the full replacement of the footbridge and tidying of the ditch underneath on FP23.

SCHOOL PARKING AROUND LOWER GREEN

Following complaints about inconsiderate and dangerous parking at school drop off and pick up times the Parish Council has written to the Head teacher of Tewin Cowper School asking for the Travel Plan to be displayed clearly on the website, parents to be reminded of no parking on the north edge of Lower Green and to respect residents and the surrounding community.

LUTON AIRPORT

In response to a query raised about the increased air traffic over Tewin, Luton Airport advised that :

- the aircraft causing disturbance in Tewin is likely to be when the easterly departure route is used which is on average about 30% of the time due to prevailing wind direction in the area.

- there are noise measures in place and fines are levied on aircraft if limits are exceeded. Fines are placed in a Community Trust Fund operating to help local communities.

- residents may like to view online flight tracking system showing tracks and altitudes.

Ever Heard of Tewin Charities?

Tewin Charities is registered by the Charities Commission (reg no 1054863) to administer funds, bequeathed long ago, for the benefit and protection of people of limited means who are going through difficult circumstances and are resident within the Parish of Tewin.

These funds have become, with the passage of time and inflation, relatively small. The Charity can foresee a situation in which its work and purpose will be seriously hampered through lack of reserves.

Tewin Charities would be enormously grateful to anyone who might be prepared to consider making a donation or bequeathing a gift to the charity when making or reviewing their will. Any bequest to a registered charity would be exempt from inheritance tax and currently an estate can pay Inheritance Tax at a reduced rate of 36% on some assets if you leave 10% or more of the 'net value' to registered charities in your will.
