Planning applications

ROSPA – Everything was satisfactory apart from the gate closing and the surface of the gate entrance which the Parish Council agreed to monitor.

Extra cuts on Upper Green Road adjacent to the ditch – The Parish Council did not agree to any further cuts. **Tewin Cricket Clubs use of Pavilion** – The Cricket Club advised that they will not be using the Pavilion as it is near the end of the season

Upper Green – The Parish Council agreed to allow the Cricket Club to use Upper Green for Tewin Cricket club Award event on 18th Sept subject to the usual stipulations.

Lower Green – The Parish Council agreed to give permission for the Harvest Festival & Tewin Stores for a BBQ on Lower Green on 19th Sept.

Fallen Oak Back Lane – The fallen oak on Back Lane was cleared by Kirkham Contracting on behalf of Rights of Way.

The Parish Council agreed to donate £750 towards the running of the Tewin Community Saturday bus and agreed to monitor the usage.
