THACS Autumn Show on Saturday 6th September 2014

Congratulations to all the exhibitors at the Autumn Show this year. This was the 13th annual Autumn Show and it attracted a record 124 exhibitors who entered 399 exhibits.

We were delighted that, thanks to the efforts of Tewins playgroups, nursery and primary school, we received entries from 83 children. Well done!

It was also encouraging to see 41 adults exhibiting, several for the first time.

The show attracted a substantial number of visitors in the afternoon and they certainly had a lot to see. Adult entries in the main hall included an array of lovely flowers and arrangements, an impressive range of fruit and vegetables, knitting, pottery, jewellery and a mouth-watering display of culinary delights whilst the Parish Room housed a full display of photographs and art exhibits.

Entries from children also covered a wide range of skills. Their horticultural class included delightful flower arrangements whilst their arts and crafts class included a large number of colourful paintings. Culinary exhibits included edible butterflies and caterpillars and imaginatively decorated fairy cakes, whilst the photography class included photos of sunsets, action and fruit & vegetables.

When it came to the prize-giving for the adults, it soon became apparent that the most successful person was Anna Clark. As you can see from the results below, her incredible effort of 37 entries over five classes resulted in her winning the Carlton Rose Bowl (flowers), the Ivor & Vaughan Williams Trophy (vegetables & fruit) and the Shire Park Bowling Club President's Shield (horticulture), as well as coming second in Flower Arranging and third in Culinary. What a remarkable achievement! Other adult winners were Mavis Haggar for Flower Arranging, Terry Brand for Arts & Crafts, Jules Bridgman for Photography and Amanda Glew for Culinary.

The most successful child exhibitor was May Carley, who came first in her age group for horticulture, arts & crafts and culinary, leading to her winning the Tewin Cowper School Parents' Association Award.

Forthcoming Events

Flower arranging presentation on Monday 13th October 2014

A flower arranging demonstration will be given in Tewin Memorial Hall on the evening of Monday 13th October, so do please come along.

The presenter will be Gill McGregor, who is a qualified and experienced floral design tutor and NAFAS demonstrator both in the UK and world-wide. Gill describes her presentations as "inspirational designs with distinction wrapped in a conversation of humour", so the evening should be enjoyable, informative and fun.

Gill has written a number of books. Her latest published book is entitled *50 techniques used in Contemporary Floral Design* and it is a learning resource to assist students learning contemporary flower arranging or for experienced flower arrangers wishing to research a variety of techniques to enhance their floral designs. Copies of Gill's books will be available for viewing and purchase. The aim of the evening is to encourage and inspire more people to have a go at flower arranging. Gill will demonstrate four different designs at a pace that will enable her to comprehensively explain their methods of construction with enthusiasm and humour. So the evening's presentation will be suitable for both the novice or less experienced aspiring flower arranger as well as for members of local Flower Clubs.



The evening starts at 7:30pm with free wine / fruit juice and nibbles. The demonstration will begin at 8:00pm and will be followed by a raffle of the resulting four displays. The evening should end by about 10:00pm.

Entrance is free to all, so come and join us and buy something unique made by a local craftsperson.

Visit to the National Gallery on Wednesday 26th November 2014

We are organising a coach trip on Wednesday 26th November to the National Gallery in Trafalgar Square.

The National Gallery houses one of the greatest collections of paintings in the world and entrance is free of charge. The Collection contains over 2,300 works, including many famous works, such as van Eyck's <u>Arnolfini Portrait</u>, Velázquez's <u>Rokeby Venus</u>, Turner's <u>Fighting</u> <u>Temeraire</u> and Van Gogh's <u>Sunflowers</u>. All major traditions of Western European painting are represented, from the artists of late medieval and Renaissance Italy to the French Impressionists. You can preview the collection on line at <u>http://www.nationalgallery.org.uk/artists/</u>. This could help you identify areas of the gallery where you may wish to spend more time.

In addition to the usual paintings on show, this autumn the National Gallery has a special exhibition '<u>Rembrandt: The Late Works</u>' - the first ever in-depth exploration of Rembrandt's final years of painting. The cost of entry to this exhibition is shown below.

If you intend viewing this exhibition we recommend you pre-book, either online via the above site or by telephone (020 7747 2885). You might be able to buy tickets on the day from the ticket desk in the Sainsbury Wing Foyer but if demand is heavy there is no guarantee of availability.

Of course there are many more attractions to see in London and don't forget that Christmas won't be far away, so why not visit the West End shops.

The coach will leave the Rose and Crown at 9:30am and leave the National Gallery for the return home at 4:00pm. The seats cost £8.50 for *THACS* members and £11.00 for nonmembers. Please book early to be sure you don't miss out.

Recent Events

Visit to RHS Wisley on Wednesday 30th July 2014

It was a lovely summer's day, ideal for our visit. The coach left Tewin at 9:00 and we had a smooth and comfortable journey. On arrival, I was pleased to find that everything was ready and waiting for us, so it did not take long to get the entrance tickets and map and guide to the gardens and to check the arrangements for the mobility scooters and for meeting for the garden tour. Fifty



people came on the visit and nine of these went on the optional guided tour, which was enjoyable and informative. The tour took about 1¹/₂ hours so there was still plenty of time for lunch and exploration.

Although we had over $4^{1/2}$ hours at Wisley, there was not time to see it all, so everyone had to make decisions about where to spend their time. One of the highlights was the famous mixed borders which were magnificent and full of colour, form and texture. I recognised several of the plants that I have in my own garden but the specimens at Wisley were more robust and much larger and healthier than mine. They are a living testimonial to the skill and dedication of the excellent gardeners there. However, I did derive some perverse pleasure in noticing a few bits of bindweed and some signs of slug damage! The glasshouse and lake were impressive and the surrounding planting has matured nicely. There were some great plant combinations to see in detail and a glorious view en masse.

All of the wonderful planting must have prompted ideas for plants at home. Several people visited the plant centre, resulting in an impressive collection of fine plants which were safely stowed in the coach's hold for the return journey. The time-keeping was excellent, so thanks to everyone in the group for helping to make the visit go so smoothly.

On the way back, there was a happy atmosphere and everyone was pleased with their purchases and what they had seen at the gardens. This trip was billed as a summer's day out to lift the spirits and it certainly was!
