AGM on Monday 11th January 2016

The fifteenth THACS AGM takes place at Tewin Memorial Hall on **Monday 11th January 2016 at 7:30pm**. The evening will start with the AGM and then there will be refreshments (including wine) followed by a talk from our guest speakers.

As you can see from the agenda, the meeting will include the Chairman's and Treasurer's report for 2015, the election of the officers and other committee members for 2016 and a preview of events for 2016. The committee is still developing the programme of events and would like to hear your suggestions for this. Our guest speakers are Mike and Anna Clark and their subject will be *From the Buchart Gardens in Vancouver to the Orchards of Washington State*. They visited old friends in Canada and Washington State where they stayed on Vancouver Island and in the

extensive Yakima Orchards to the east of Seattle over three weeks, celebrating Anna's birthday with visits to the beautiful Buchart Gardens and several fruit growing centres. Their illustrated talk will show the diversity of flowers and fruit as well as a remarkable Folk Museum. Staying in the foothills of Mt Baker at Glacier, in a log cabin next to rapids, they also toured Mt Ranier and Salt Lake Island where an organic orchard featured red flesh apples.

There is no admission charge for the evening and no booking is necessary. This is an important meeting for THACS and all members are urged to attend. Non-members are very welcome but not able to vote.

4. A tranquil scene	4. * Parks and gardens
5. * People at work	5. Close up of a household object

The Adult Section consists of all ten categories and the Children's Section consists of the six categories marked with *.

In the July newsletter, we undertook to set the handicraft categories for the 2016 shows early and publish them in this newsletter in order to give exhibitors more time to produce their handiwork.

The adult handicraft categories for both shows are as follows:-

Spring 2016

1. Stitched household object (for example, tea cosy, cushion cover, draught excluder, apron.)
2. Embroidered Easter motif on a handkerchief (for example, Easter chick, bunny, egg.)

Autumn 2016

1. An object made from wood. Space allowed 30cm x30cm (12ins x12ins)
2. Soft toy, any material
3. Hand knitted garment. Space allowed 60cm x 60cm (24ins x 24ins)


Please remember that these are your shows, so your committee needs your guidance to ensure that the shows reflect the interests of THACS
