## **Planning Applications**

3/25/0944/HH - 7 The Walled Garden, Tewin Water, Tewin - Replacement rooflights, windows and doors from painted timber to Upvc including enlarging opening to suit bifold doors at rear – *TPC to request a condition to ensure that the replacement windows matched the other houses in line with a previous application 3/19/0269/HH*.

3/25/0495/APRN - Fire Tenders Query – Tewin Parish Council has tried to raise concerns about the ability of fire tenders to reach this site, but Hertfordshire Building Control has provided the following responses to the Parish Council's questions:

- a. Building Control advised that they do look into access for fire tenders during the build process but they would usually consider fire service access at completion, as the inspection process focuses on the building. They may only visit a new build five or six times at stages that will identify the greatest number of Building Regulation compliance issues. They would not routinely inspect the road makeup. However, at the final inspection, fire service access would be a material consideration.
- b. Building Control are not made aware of any problems that the Parish Council raise at the planning stage as Building Control and Planning are two separate processes. However, Requirement B5 is a Building Regulation but Fire Service Access is not a material planning consideration, primarily as this is controlled during construction. It is possible to provide automatic water suppression (sprinklers) to the building if the fire service access is not as per the guidance.
- c. The Parish Council cannot comment directly to building control in relation to a particular scheme as there is not a consultation process with a Building Regulation application.
- d. The Parish Council cannot express their concerns into the process of checking that the application conforms to the Building Regulations. The process of checking compliance is dictated by MHCLG, and in the event of non-compliance with the guidance, consultation will be carried out with the Fire Authority.

**Town & Parish Council Forum** – The slides from this meeting on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2025 have been circulated.

#### 31. FINANCE

Accounts for Payment - In accordance with the Council's Financial Regulations the schedule of payments approved by the Parish Council totalled £5,877.88 and comprised: Kirkham Contracting £1,538.59, Kirkham Contracting £2,220.32, C McFarlane £908.71, NEST £98.33, Xero Direct debit £39.60, 4Wire £331.33, Cain Marking £450 and Lock And Key Centre £291.

**External Audit** – A qualification has been placed on the audit due to the incorrect PWLB loan balance entered on the form. **Internal Audit** - The internal audit date is to be confirmed.

**Income versus expenditure and the Budget** – Income currently comprises of the Precept and Interest income only. Reimbursements due from Tewin Pavilion CIC, Tewin Tennis Club and Tewin Allotments amount to £1,382.69 for: fire alarm service, remedial works, PAT test, tennis court maintenance, keys and fencing.

Expenditure is in line with the budget except for Election Costs as an unexpected invoice for the 2023 Election was received from East Herts Council. Insurance expenditure was lower than the budget at £1,158 versus a budget of £1,400.

## 32. HIGHWAYS

**Broken Gates** – The Clerk emailed the ROW Unit for an update on the gates on 1.7.25 and the Parish Council agreed to ask Kirkham Contracting for a quote to tidy up, remove, replace various gates.

**Orchard Road Closure** – Various ditching and drainage works are scheduled for 29<sup>th</sup> July until 7<sup>th</sup> August and the road will be closed from 9.30am until 4pm.

**Tewin Hill Fencing** – These post and rail works are scheduled for 26<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> August and the road will be closed from 7.30am until 5pm.

# 33. PAVILION & UPPER GREEN

Weekly Playground Inspections - Nothing to report.

**Pavilion Fire Alarm Service** – The remedial works are due to take place on 22<sup>nd</sup> July at 9am

**Pavilion PAT testing** – These works are due to take place on 22<sup>nd</sup> July at 9am.

**Pavilion Keys**- 14 Pavilion keys have been ordered and received and Tewin Tennis Club will reimburse the Parish Council.

**Tennis Court Hedging** – A meeting was held with Tewin Tennis Club and Kirkham Contracting to obtain a quote for hedge trimming around the tennis courts. The hanging trellis, leaning fence and overhanging trees were also reported to Sovereign Network Group.

**Fire Damage on Upper Green** – The Parish Council noted that there had been some fire damage to the grass and part of a railway sleeper on Upper Green. The green directional sign from the path by the Pavilion has also been burnt.

## 34. LOWER GREEN

**Litter Bins** - A complaint has been raised with East Herts Council about litter bins not being emptied on a regular basis. East Herts Council advised that the original missed emptying was when the usual operative was on annual leave. Customer Service capacity to manage reporting of missed litter bin emptying is currently being affected by the new waste contract and should improve over time as they move forward with the new provider.

**Damaged Telegraph pole** – The damaged telegraph pole at the entrance to Godfries Close has now been replaced.

Benches – Consider allowing TCC to anchor the benches out all the times – TPC agreed to allow – Cricket Club agreed to leave them out in the summer and put them away during the winter.

Sovereign – Email submitted about overhanging trellis, leaning fence and overhanging tree branches over FP15

May Pond Green – Remove ivy from the wall – Cllr J Sheridan agreed to do.

Lower Green – School parking on the bend – Raise with the Police at the beginning of the new term in September.

Hertford Rd – Lousehole Bottom Ditch – Cllr J Sheridan agreed to clear.

Grass Warren – Weeds on Pavement – Reported to Sovereign.

Grass Warren – Broken Birdsmouth fencing – Reported to Sovereign.

Grass Warren - Overgrown hedge outside 8 Grass Warren - Reported to Sovereign 30.5.25

St Peters- Reinstate 2 posts – Agreed to await the pros and cons for various alternative options from Kirkham Contracting.

Margery Lane – Remove ivy from trees – Cllr J Sheridan agreed to clear.

Tewin Hill – Roadside fence still down – Highways scheduled to do works.

Ash Tree on Queen Hoo Lane – Works due to be completed on 9<sup>th</sup> July.
