Planning Applications

3/25/1225/FUL - Seven Pines, Margery Lane, Tewin - Demolition of bungalow and erection of two dwellings – TPC Object

3/25/1369/HH - 44 Orchard Road, Tewin - Demolition of existing extensions and erecting double storey side/rear extension with rear dormer window and single storey rear extension – TPC No Comment

3/25/1431/HH - 12 Desborough Drive, Tewin Wood - Demolition of rear porch. Erection of single storey extension. Erection of porch. Alterations to fenestration and landscaping - *TPC No Comment*

3/25/1492/HH - 23 Firs Walk, Tewin - Demolish existing rear garage extension. Convert garage into habitable space. Construct single-storey side extension, two-storey front extension, and two-storey rear extension with balcony. Raise existing roof, install solar panels and skylights - *TPC Object*

55. FINANCE

Accounts for Payment - In accordance with the Council's Financial Regulations the schedule of payments approved by the Parish Council comprised: C McFarlane £934.31, NEST £101.52, Xero £39.60, HMRC PAYE £1088.65, Cruz Microsystems £660, PKF Littlejohn £378.00, Open Spaces Society £45.00, Kirkham Contracting £216, Kirkham Contracting £144.

External Audit – PKF Littlejohn have completed the audit with no qualifications and notices have been put on the website and the notice board.

Lower Green Cubicle Electricity Supply – The backdated invoice £688.74 for the period 28.2.2022 ~ 31.5.2025 was queried with EON and sent to the back billing department. A revised bill of £198.15 for the last 12 months less £40 compensation has been received. The Parish Council agreed by email to pay and the invoice has been paid. **HMRC PAYE** – The PAYE penalty has been waived.

Clerk's Computer – The Clerk's computer has been upgraded by Qtek in order to accommodate Windows 11.

Allotment Tenancy – This expires on 4.4.2026 and the landowners advised that they would be in contact in due course.

Income & Expenditure versus the Budget - A report was circulated and everything is broadly in line with the budget.

VAT Reclaim – A VAT reclaim for £1,509 has been submitted for the quarter ending 30th September 2025.

56. HIGHWAYS

Broken Gates – Kirkham Contracting advised that he has a back injury and hopes to get the works done in October. **School Lane** – Further works have been completed on this section of sinking road.

57. PAVILION & UPPER GREEN

Weekly Playground Inspections - Nothing to report.

Pavilion – **Exterior Repairs and Painting** – A quote for £4,300 has been received and includes labour, materials as well as replacing some wooden soffit board with UPVC. Cllr B Evans is in the process of obtaining three other quotes.

Pavilion Showers – The showerheads have been removed for the winter.

Tennis Court Hedging – Kirkham Contracting hopes to complete these works during October.

Sovereign Network Group – The Clerk will ask Sovereign for an update on the works order raised for the hanging trellis and leaning fence to be made safe interim as well as progress re trimming the trees overhanging the tennis courts at Upper Green.

58. LOWER GREEN

Telephone Box – The replacement plastic window for the telephone box has been fitted.

Rose & Crown – Cllr D Howson agreed to raise the concerns that there was no room for bus passengers to disembark with the landlord again.

Policing & Parking – The PCSO's attended Lower Green on 17th September 2025 for a Street Meet. No parking issues were seen but parishioners raised the issue of speeding. The Parish Council agreed to speak to the Headmistress and ask the PCSO's to return as parking on the bend opposite the Bowls Club continues to be a daily issue. The Parish Council agreed to contact the Drive Safe team about using the speed indicating devices.

Away Changing Room – Door damaged - CIC aware and will be undertaken as part of interior decoration.

Sovereign – Agreed to repair overhanging trellis, leaning fence and overhanging tree branches over FP15

Lower Grass Warren - Weeds on Pavement - Reported to Sovereign. Clerk to chase

Grass Warren - Broken Birdsmouth fencing - Reported to Sovereign. Clerk to chase

Grass Warren – Overgrown hedge outside 8 Grass Warren – Reported to Sovereign 30.5.25. Cllr D Lloyd advised half the hedge has been cut. Clerk to contact Kirkham Contracting and Sovereign.

St Peters- Reinstate 2 posts – The Parish Council agreed to use a few of the granite kerbstones from Lower Green.

Todd's Green – Removing 5 x tree stumps and flail mowing area – Completed.

Tree Risk Assessment – Area 3 Bramfield Road and Queen Hoo Lane – A further quote has been obtained for £5,250 no vat and this compares to the quote of £4,704 excl vat from Rob Cooper. The Parish Council agreed to accept the quote from Clinton Wilkinson and ask for any chippings to go to the Allotment Association.

60. CORRESPONDENCE

Herts Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP) – This public consultation started on 25th September and ends on Wednesday 5th November.

Garages in Tewin – A request for information about garages to hire in Tewin was directed to East Herts Council and Welwyn Hatfield Council as there are no longer garages for rent in Tewin.
