Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council meeting held on Monday 12th July 2013 in Tewin Memorial Hall at 7.30pm.

44. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE were received from Cllrs B.Evans, A.Hill, D. Howson, K.Lawson and N.Moore.

PARISHIONERS COMMENTS

The resident of 1 Churchfield Road attended to outline the planning application submitted for the property.

46. TREE WORK

A quote of £1200 from Ashley Trees has been received for various essential trees located on VG70, CL148, CL149 and CL129 as identified in the annual risk assessment. A number of the trees are in reach of the road and have dead wood overhanging the road. All Councillors have received details of the proposed tree works.

Cllr J.Sheridan proposed that this quote be accepted in view of the essential nature of the works, the Parish Council has used this tree expert in the past and been satisfied with the work, the work has been identified as part of the annual risk assessment and it is a reasonable quote. Cllr D.Lloyd seconded the proposal and the vote was unanimous.

Cllr J Sheridan proposed that the tree works be financed by the Contingency Fund which currently totals £2000 as it has not been subject to any expenditure this year. Cllr D.Lloyd seconded the proposal and the vote was unanimous.
