For adults, there will be 1st prize certificate in each of the five categories with an additional certificate awarded to the photograph selected as best in show by the judge. For children, there will be an exciting small age-appropriate 1st prize for each age group in each of the three children's categories, with a bonus prize certificate awarded to the photograph selected as best in show by the judge. The winners will be announced and all entries will be displayed on the *THACS* page of the Tewin Village website as soon as possible after the judging.
