

Autumn Show on Saturday 24th September

The *THACS* Autumn Show will be held in Tewin Memorial Hall on Saturday 24th September. It's a great showcase for some of the many talents of local people, so please support this event by exhibiting some of your handiwork. There will be show classes covering flower arranging, flowers, vegetables & fruit, arts & crafts, photography and culinary, so I am sure that you can select some suitable categories to enter.

There is also a wide range of age-appropriate categories for children, from pre-school to those leaving junior school at the end of year 7. If you are looking after your children or grandchildren during the long summer holiday, then please encourage them to select something suitable to make and enter into the show.

This show has new challenges for secondary school pupils (school years 8-13). In previous shows, we have included categories specifically suitable for these youngsters but these did not attract many entries. The quality of their exhibits was high but the thrill of winning a prize must have been dulled by the lack of competition. That's not going to happen this time because we are challenging the youngsters to compete directly with the grown-ups! For this show, there are no categories specifically for secondary school children. If you were in school years 8-13 during the academic year 2021-2022, then you will be regarded as an adult and so are eligible to enter any of the adult classes. This gives you the widest ever range of categories you can enter, with the prospect of real competition and sweet victory if you beat the adults. Are you up for the challenge?
