Art workshop on Thursday 1st May 2014

Six THACS members and one guest gathered at Bramfield Village Hall on a fine spring day for a workshop under the leadership of Jude O'Sullivan.

The participants were asked to bring an object that was personal to them, for example an item of clothing, a piece of jewellery, an ornament or something from nature such as a shell or stone found on the beach. They took this as a starting point and then developed their work with a variety of materials and techniques.

Bramfield Village Hall proved to be a wonderful venue for the light provided by the floor to ceiling windows and the views over the countryside. It was a very comfortable place to spend the day, with good facilities. A delicious and substantial "bring and share" lunch was enjoyed by all.

Open Gardens on Sunday 18th May 2014

On Sunday 18th May, the sun shone, the gardens were stunning and every visitor enjoyed a great day out.

Once again our skilful and enthusiastic gardeners had produced marvellous displays ranging from Thrift Cottage where people were interested in the garden, the pond with the vegetarian Grass Carp but also the history and construction of the cottage. Queen Hoo proved a great attraction to our visitors and model railway enthusiasts were delighted to see the trains running on time when visiting Upper Green Road with four gardens open and the opportunity to purchase similar plants to those on display in the gardens. The first port of call for many was Churchfield Road to view the beautiful cottage garden and then onto Tewin Allotments where they learned some great techniques on vegetable growing followed by another wonderful example of a cottage garden in Hertford Road. Many visitors then rounded off their afternoon in Orchard Road relaxing with a cup of tea and a delicious piece of cake.

It was delightful to go round all 10 gardens, simply because there was so much to enjoy in each one – and not least, people! Our garden owners were wonderful hosts, and gave so much – not only of their time, but their knowledge when quizzed about their gardens, and even their baking.

Huge thanks to all our gardeners and to our visitors who made the day such a success, it enabled THACS to donate £250 to Isabel Hospice.

At the end there were no plants left and a goodly sum was deposited with Pat Fulford for the benefit of the Tewin Memorial Hall. Thanks are due to all our helpers who worked so hard to load, identify, price and sell. Now, please get going with all those cuttings for next year!

The Tewin Society Award
