We look forward to seeing you there.


Recent Events

Open Gardens on Sunday 22nd May

The Tewin Open Gardens event offered a rare opportunity to explore the secrets of hidden and private gardens that are not usually open to the public.

Nine local gardens opened to visitors and there was a very wide variety of garden sizes, designs and styles including Tewin Allotment Association, who kindly opened the allotments. The other open gardens included shady woodland gardens, Thrift cottage (with its great emphasis on working with the environment), sunny pristine town gardens and most types in between. With such a wide diversity, it was not surprising that all of the visitors seem to have found at least one garden that they loved. Some visitors came to just enjoy the gardens, whilst others were seeking inspiration and a chance to swap gardening tips and ideas. It seems that they all found what they were looking for and enjoyed the event.

The previous week had started with dire forecasts for the weather



but, as it progressed, we saw a steady improvement and we had the best day saved for the open gardens event. With a warm sunny day, the number of visitors to our village was tremendous: - more than three hundred people toured the various gardens around Tewin.

Once again, the plant stall run by Maureen Yates was hugely popular and generated over $\pounds 200$ for Tewin Stores, whilst the refreshments provided by Ann Lee and her helpers raised over $\pounds 700$ for Isabel Hospice.

Our sincere thanks and appreciation goes to all of the Open Garden owners, whose inspirational gardens were a pleasure to see.
