FREE MICROCHIPPING FOR YOUR DOG IN MARCH

The law is changing – from April 6, all dogs aged eight weeks old and over must be microchipped and their keeper's details must be up to date or owners may face a fine.

To help dog owners comply with the law, East Herts Council is offering residents a final chance to get their pet microchipped for free.

To ensure lost dogs have the best possible chance of being swiftly reunited with their owner, it's important that owners ensure their dog always wears a collar and a tag displaying their contact details, and that they keep their microchip database details up to date.

The council is offering free chipping and advice in March at:

Footpath Works

The majority of the new footpath has been completed and Taylor Wimpey are due to complete their section across the front of the garage site in the next 4-6 weeks although this may be delayed due to problems with the services on the site. Oak bollards will be

installed on May Pond Green to deter parking on the footpath crossover opposite Tewin Hill in the next 4 weeks. The planting of Wild Service trees on May Pond Green has been completed.

Highways Meeting

On 8th December 2015 Cllr K St Pier and Cllr A Hill met with James Vine, the new District Service Agent who looks after the maintenance of roads. If any gullies are blocked and causing an issue such as pooling or flooding which is impeding traffic then it will go on the list for the CCTV & Drainage Investigation Programme which is currently full up until the end of April 2016. This list is subject to prioritisation and photographic and video evidence of problem gullies has been sent.

Gulley Dig Out Programme

Tewin Parish Council have identified 4 priority gullies which have been submitted to Herts County Cllr Ken Crofton for the special gulley dig out programme arranged by Highways. The 4 gullies comprise : Churchfield Road/B1000 gulley, Tewin Cowper School gulley, 56 Upper Green/Taylor Wimpey gulley and Hertford Road opposite Tewin Stores gulley.

Potholes

Potholes located in Hertford Road, Tewin Hill, Grass Warren and Margery Lane have all been reported to Herts Highways during January.

Surface Dressing on Churchfield Road

The Parish Council agreed to report the rapid deterioration of the recently completed surface dressing on Churchfield Road to Herts County Councillor Ken Crofton at Herts Highways. This has now been referred to the contractor.

Grass Cutting

St Peter's Church have just completed the extension of the churchyard by adding an area of about 11m by 75m from the glebe field. The Parish Council currently pay for grass cutting in the churchyard and have agreed to add the new land to their grass cutting schedule at a cost of £15 per cut for 10 cuts per annum.



Dropped Kerb Warning To Householders

Householders are reminded that only Hertfordshire County Council can create a vehicle crossover outside your home, following reports of illegal dropped kerbs being installed.

The reminder comes after a Watford resident paid out more than £1,000 to an individual claiming to work for the county council's highways department to install a dropped kerb.

By law, only the highways authority and its appointed contractors can carry out this work and planning permission may be required. It is illegal to damage the public highway. Terry Douris, Cabinet Member for Highways, said:

"People should be on their guard from anyone calling at their door and claiming to work for the county council or one of our contractors. Our officers would never call at your home to offer you a dropped kerb or carry out unplanned private works."

"If you have an illegal crossover installed you may have to pay for the work to be redone or even reinstate the old kerb if it does not meet the required standards."


