Tewin Music Festival Meeting Notes 26.11.2025

These notes contain some extra information that was made available at the meeting held in Tewin Memorial Hall on the 26th November 2025.

They are not minutes of that meeting. These are notes provided by Tewin Parish Council, without any guarantee that they are a correct representation, and things will change anyway.

Event Date: 18/19 July 2026

Name: Tewin Sound

Saturday: music based

Sunday : live cooking, wine tasting, ferris wheel, invite locals businesses and pubs food trucks.

Attendees: The expected number of attendees is 12k on the Saturday and around 8k on the Sunday.

Being run by Sound Live Limited, not Tewinbury directly.

Tewinbury have say over whether to continue after first year.

Jobs: 100 jobs available for local people for 4 days

Tickets: Free tickets x 2000 for the village. Rules on resale... no resale.

Set Up: 2/4 weeks -set up fencing etc. Access up Churchfield Road, marshaled to a timetable. Currently no weight limit on Churchfield Road bridge.

Parking: VIP and accessible parking = 800 cars only. They will have access up Churchfield Road.

Apart from the above, no other public parking on site.

Rail and Ride tickets : Coaches from WGC and Stevenage stations.

They will talk to the train companies to arrange extra late night trains.

Park and Ride tickets: University of Hertfordshire site at Hatfield.

Coaches from London etc

Welwyn North Station : Walk along concrete path to/ from Welwyn north Station

Will be heavily stewarded along the footpath to Welwyn North possibly with lights and back to Transport Hub to ensure everyone gets away.

Seem confident they can stop people parking and walking into the festival.

Coaches will use the transport hub in field accessed from B1000 opposite Waterside.

Pick up and drop off area also available in transport hub.

They will build pedestrian bridge over Mimram to connect transport hub with main site.

B1000 closed from Hens Lane to Bessemer Road

Vehicle Passes for local residents (ask for how many you need)

Visitors for clubs (pubs etc??) will get guest passes

Delivery vehicles will be allowed through

No one parking in the village.

Not clear at this stage how far this exclusion zone will extend. Burnham Green? New Road?

They will be in contact with emergency services, so by the time an emergency vehicle reaches the exclusion zone, the access will be clear.

No camping

There will be plenty of litter points and water stations

There will be Hot line from set up from to break down

There will be police presence.

11 pm close. Stages will be silenced in staggered way.

Staff on all access points.

Estimate one hour to clear 10,000 people from site

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Encourage local businesses to get involved

Festival goers will have a hologram wristband

Traffic management proposal due in a few weeks, with updates right up to a month before as & when necessary.

If there are any problems with the traffic management plan then it won't go ahead

Conservation plan.... Land management plan for post festival as well.

They will make a donation to Isabel Hospice

They want to put some money back into the village ... ideas welcome

There will be a Festival website
